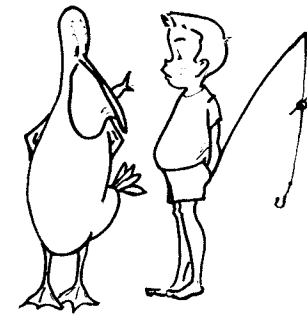
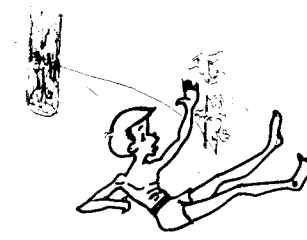




ACCOMMODATIONS: The Island, though still natural and quaint, has modern motels, cottages and houses available.



BIRD LOVERS: Dauphin Island is a main point of migration and is visited by ornithologists from near and far. The native woods and water birds are plentiful. 173 acre Audubon Bird Sanctuary with a lake at the east end of Dauphin Island.



DUNES: Have you ever seen 30 foot dunes with pines growing from them? You can't keep children from the fun of sliding down!



FISHING: Fabulous fishing, nearly everything that swims in salt water, and within a few miles of many fresh water streams, such as Fowl River on which is located fabulous Bellingrath Gardens. Fishing guides and boats are plentiful.

HISTORY: Settled in 1699 by the Spanish, but the Indians had long been there, and left mounds of oyster shells symbolic of their Calumets, or "pow wows." Later Dauphin Island was the Port of Entry of the entire Louisiana Territory.

HURRICANES: There is a lot of misinformation on hurricanes. No life was ever lost on Dauphin Island because of one. The trees are a tribute to the protection that the dunes have given to Dauphin Island.



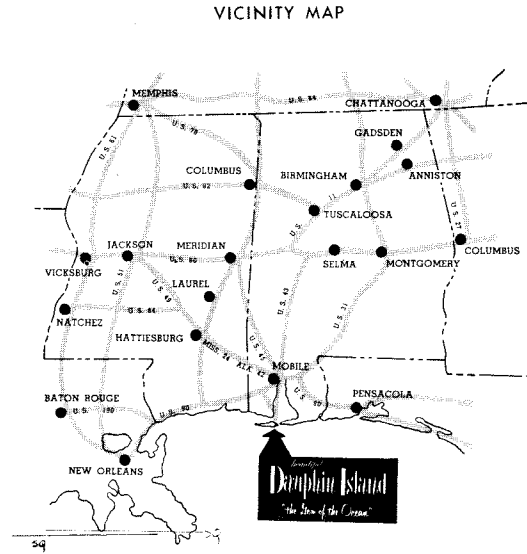
OYSTERS: The world's best oysters from some of the world's most prolific oyster beds. See them being taken from the Bay bottom when you cross the bridge.

STAR GAZERS: No city smoke and smog to restrict your enjoyment of astronomy.



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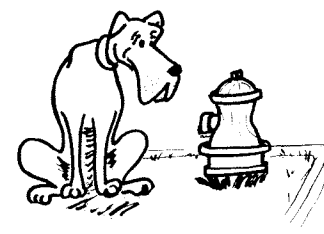


AIRPORT: 3000' paved runway with tie-down park. Excellent clearance; under construction.

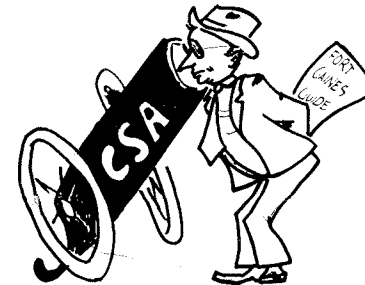


BOATING: For trailer boats, launching ramps and water galore. For large boats, 2 marinas and many bays offer great protection in all weather.

MAP: Map on reverse side speaks for itself in exciting graphics.

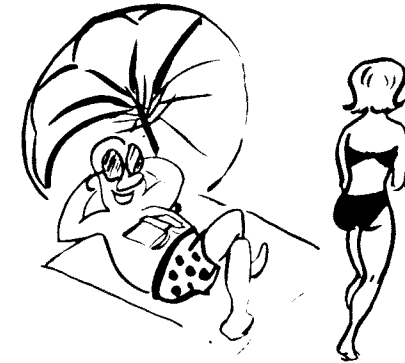

SCHOOLS: Primary School, a part of the Mobile School System. Through the 6th grade on the Island and a school bus takes higher grade pupils to Bayou La Batre. Mobile County has 3 colleges and many other fine schools.

SCIENTISTS: You will be most interested in the Gulf Coast Shellfish Sanitation Research Center of the U. S. Public Health Service and the State of Alabama Marine Resources Laboratory; and the Air Force Radar Station on Dauphin Island.

SHELLS: 14 miles of Gulf front to explore, a change with every wave and tide.

ARTISTS: Dauphin Island is a favorite locale for many of you.

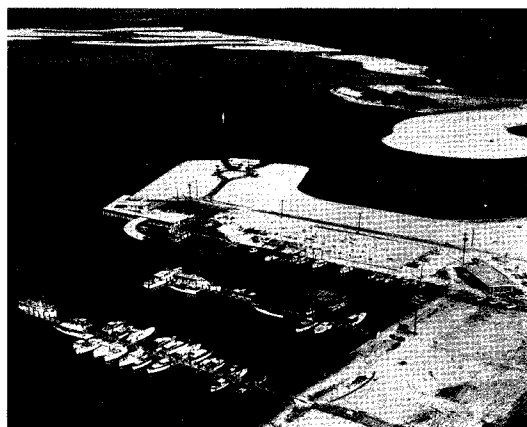

METROPOLIS: Mobile only 35 miles away offers everything you would expect to find in a progressive city of a quarter million.

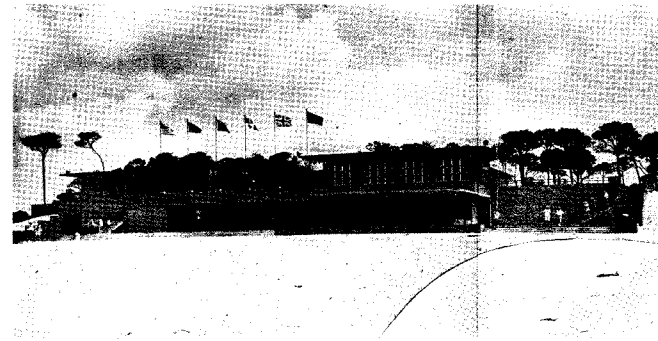
NATURE LOVERS: Dauphin Island has not been spoiled and still possesses the natural feel and look. Here is the place to give your children a sincere love of and respect for nature.
